VIR2ALL – Blue Electro sound programs also include predefined settings for a variety of MIDI controllers (e.g. Modulation Wheel, Pitch Wheel, Aftertouch, Velocity) for real-time control of the various modulation parameters. The predefined settings were selected very meticulously in order to achieve fluid transitions across the entire range of each controller. We highly recommend the use of these controllers for the maximum utilization of the sound programs.

Loading Files

VIR2ALL – Blue Electro sound program collection is provided in standard MIDI File (*.mid). To load the MIDI files to your instrument use a software sequencer such as Steinberg Cubase, Emagic Logic or similar. First, upload the *.mid files as standard MIDI project tracks. Next, select the correct MIDI channel for your Access Virus synthesizer, set the tempo between 80 - 100 BPM and then start the playback.

Note

Please backup your current sound programs before uploading the VIR2ALL – Blue Electro sound program collection into your Access Virus synthesizer.

Soundware Description

The VIR2ALL - Blue Electro soundware collection contains one shot chords, pads, basses, plucks, leads, arpeggios, syncs, noise based programs and sound effects designed for IDM, Dark Pop, Ambient, Dark Ambient, Synth Pop, Experimental and Retro music styles.

We recommend the use of the predefined MIDI controllers for the real-time adjustment of modulation parameters when working with these programs.
